1. Treasurers Report: We have collected 8 more due's payments. There are 2 payments still delinquent. Our insurance policy has been paid and \$5475. 00 has been paid to Obering and Wurth for engineering work completed thus far. Steve, Celeste and Jill will meet at the bank to put all 3 names on the checking account bank signature card to be able to write checks.

- 2. Drainage Issue Update: Vince explained the three different proposals given by the engineers to fix the drainage flow to 25 Langley PI from the common drive off Broadmoor Bluffs. Jill made a motion to proceed with design option 3, Vince seconded the motion, the board passed the vote.
- 3. Architectural Control: Letters will be sent to homeowners for covenant and rules violations.

Charles Ham volunteered to be on the Architectural Control Committee. Steve made a motion, Beth seconded it, the board passed the vote. Covenants are updated through the HOA Policies and Rules.

- 4. Paint for fences: The SKU for obtaining the paint at Home Depot is on the MOHA website.
- 5. Maintenance Update: Landscaping Specialists are doing a great job, killing weeds, removing leaves. We have them come 3 times a year: Spring, Summer, and Fall.]
- 6. Missing sidewalk on Langley: Curbing around island on Langley is in poor shape. Sections are missing in front of 25 Langley. The city has a program where they pay half

and the homeowner pays half. Vince and his neighbors have signed up for that. They are asking that MOHA split their half with them.

- 7. Polybutylene Plumbing (Information Only): Replacement of aging polybutylene plumbing with PEX or copper plumbing is becoming a condition for the sale of homes in our area between buyers and sellers. Polybutylene plumbing was installed in our homes when they were new but only has a life expectancy of 25 years when they start to corrode or leak. Homeowners can check their plumbing with an inspection from a reliable plumbing company.
- 8. Mailboxes: We plan to get started on the mailboxes ASAP. Steve made a motion to complete the installation in 4 phases. Sample mail posts and boxes will be installed around the neighborhood in the next 45 days. Beth seconded the motion and the Board passed the vote.

The meeting adjourned at 8:04 pm. The Board then met in Executive Session to discuss legal matters.
